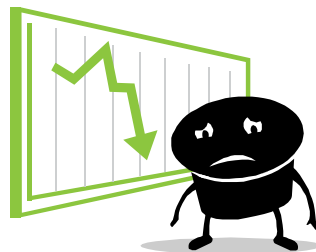
Financial Literacy is designed to give individuals the ability to understand basic finance and their own financial situation.
